

# Mr. Basketball & Miss Basketball Minnesota Showcase

## Parent Info Sheet

We are excited to have your son/daughter's team competing in the Minnesota Showcase in Mankato. The tournament will feature 28 mens and womens teams from 4 states. All games will be played at the Taylor Center at MSU. The Minnesota Showcase is a very competitive tournament that will have a great fan following and atmosphere! Here are some quick notes to answer questions our staff often get.

- All-day admission is \$10 for adults and \$7 for students (k-8). A weekend pass will be available for \$30 for adults and \$21 for students. These waterproof wristbands allow you to pay on the first day and simply show your wristband the next three days as you re-enter the gyms.
- Throughout the event, games will be played on two courts in the Main Arena of the Taylor Center, along with one court in the Schellberg Gym. All of the gyms are air conditioned and offer plenty of seating. Access to Schellberg is through the main doors of the Taylor Center and then a walk down the hallway.
- MSU has summer classes in session and parking permits are enforced by campus security. Please be aware of what lot you are posting in. Most of the time lots will be clearly marked or having parking enforcement personnel on site.
- NCAA coaches are prohibited from having contact with a prospect or the prospect's parents, family, coaches, and/or any other individual associated with the prospect as a result of her participation in basketball. Please avoid any situations at the gym, motels or restaurants that could be an NCAA violation.
- We have a computerized stats program and will post box scores and other items in the main arena and on our website during the tournament. The results, box scores and stat leaders are available on the "Game Day Info Page" for the Minnesota Showcase.
- MSU's concession stand will be NOT be open during the event. Players should plan accordingly for water, etc.
- Results will be updated on our website immediately after each hour's games are completed.
